



## MINING REHABILITATION ADVISORY PANEL

### COMMUNIQUE – June 2016

#### A summary of the Mining Rehabilitation Advisory Panel's Meeting on 8 June 2017

#### **1. Abandoned Mines Program - Black Diamond**

The Panel noted that the final stage of rehabilitation has commenced at Black Diamond. The revegetation works, which were supported by young students from Allanson Primary School, consist of seeding and erosion control to improve the visual amenity of the area and promote community connection with the site. The seed mix for the revegetation project was donated by Collie coal company Griffin Coal. All revegetation works will be completed by 30 June 2017.

#### **2. Abandoned Mines Program – Ellendale**

The panel noted that the Kimberley region has experienced a significant wet season in which the previous works completed at the abandoned Ellendale Diamond Mine site, have maintained their structural integrity. The site remains safe, stable and non-polluting.
