



## Application for excess tonnage

When the prescribed tonnage limit will be exceeded by any proposed ground-disturbing activities on mining tenements, an application for excess tonnage can be submitted to the Title Compliance Branch via [Mineral Titles Online \(MTO\)](#) or lodged over the counter at a Mining Registrar's office.

An application for excess tonnage is required where the prescribed tonnage limit of 500 tonnes on a Prospecting (P) licence or Special prospecting licence, 1,000 tonnes for an Exploration (E) licence and Retention licence will be exceeded by proposed activities.

Tonnage on tenements is cumulative for the entire life of the tenement and is not refreshed by rehabilitation.

In applying for excess tonnage, applicants need to provide the information required in the form below as well as:

- The Programme of Works (PoW) Registration ID (Reg ID) associated with the application or a copy of the PoW with the proposed activities relating to the application.
- Letter of authorisation by the tenement holder (where required).
- Agreement from the affected Registered Native Title Party (where required)
  - A letter of consent from the Registered Native Title Party
  - A [statutory declaration](#) from the applicant stating that they have agreement from the affected Registered Native Title Party to future approvals or consent to excess tonnage.
