The Mines Safety and Inspection Regulations 1995 [rr. 3.45-3.47] requires the applicant to submit the following documentation.

- Certified copy of appropriate degree with the academic transcript (if the degree is from a non-Australian or New Zealand institution also attached letter of assessment from the Overseas Qualification Unit)* for either of the following:
 - (a) degree or diploma in mine surveying technology from Curtin University of Western Australian School of Mines
 - (b) three year diploma in mine surveying from the Department of Technical and Further Education (TAFE)
 - (c) surveying qualifications from any school of mines, university, institute of technology or technical college deemed by the Board to be equivalent to a qualification referred to (a) or (b) above.
 - For Grade 1 certificate – evidence of at least two mining units and a geology unit
 - For Grade 2 certificate – evidence of at least one mining unit
- Evidence of practical experience, which must include**
 - For Grade 1 certificate – evidence of having made underground surveys under supervision for a period of not less than 24 months (evidence to be verified by a Grade 1 Authorised Mine Surveyor)
 - For Grade 2 certificate – evidence of having made surveys of quarry operations under supervision for a period of not less than 12 months (evidence to be verified by a Grade 1 or 2 Authorised Mine Surveyor)
- Character reference
- Proof of identity documents (e.g. passport or driver's licence)

** letters of experience must be provided and signed off by a responsible officer of the company in which experience has been gained using company letterhead. It should include precise details of the types of duties and dates associated with each.

Inquiries, if conducted, to establish accuracy of experience given in the form of a Statutory Declaration may cause delays in the finalisation of a decision on your application.
