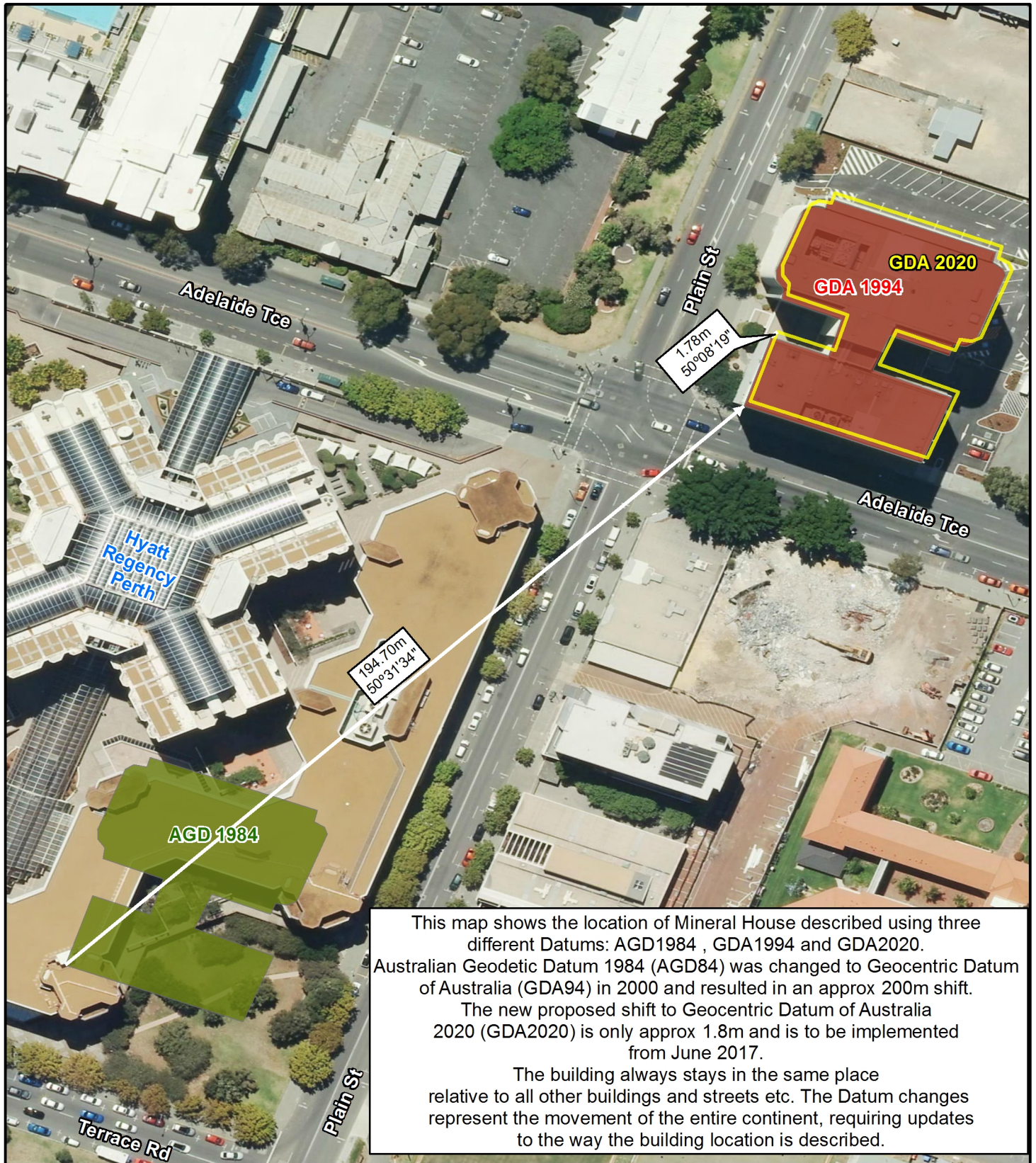


# Datum Shift AGD1984, GDA1994 & GDA2020

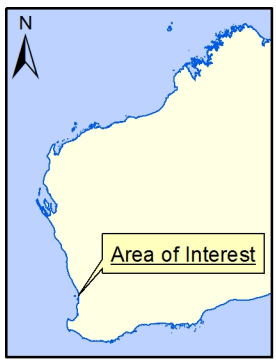


This map shows the location of Mineral House described using three different Datums: AGD1984 , GDA1994 and GDA2020. Australian Geodetic Datum 1984 (AGD84) was changed to Geocentric Datum of Australia (GDA94) in 2000 and resulted in an approx 200m shift. The new proposed shift to Geocentric Datum of Australia 2020 (GDA2020) is only approx 1.8m and is to be implemented from June 2017.

The building always stays in the same place relative to all other buildings and streets etc. The Datum changes represent the movement of the entire continent, requiring updates to the way the building location is described.
