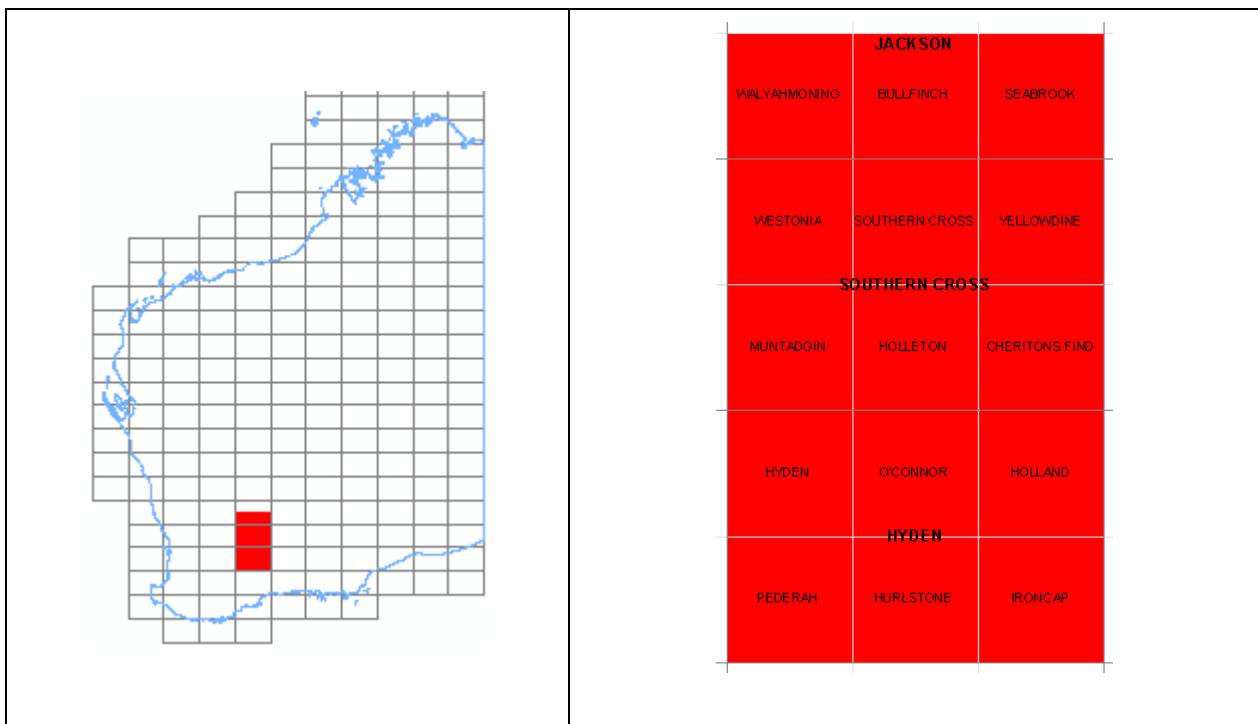
## Forthcoming geophysical data releases

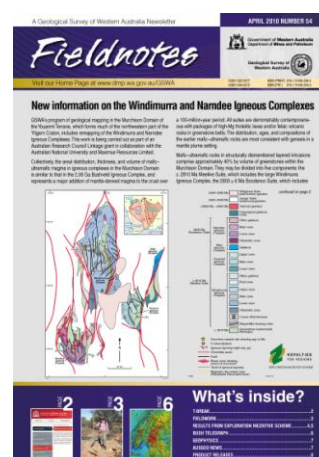
