



## **Western Australian mines inspectorate boundaries as at March 2011**

References to latitude and longitude are based on the Geocentric Datum of Australia 1994 (GDA94).

### **West inspectorate**

Follow the southern and western coasts of WA from the point where longitude 121°E crosses the southern coast to the point where latitude 24°S crosses the western coast.

East along latitude 24°S to longitude 121°E.

South along longitude 121°E until latitude 26°S.

West along latitude 26°S until longitude 119°40'E.

South along longitude 119°40'E until latitude 31°21'S.

East along latitude 31°21'S to longitude 121°E.

South along longitude 121°E until the point where longitude 121°E crosses the southern coast.

### **North inspectorate**

Follow the western and northern coasts of WA from the point where latitude 24°S crosses the western coast to the point where the WA-NT border crosses the northern coast.

South along the WA-NT border until latitude 26°S.

West along latitude 26°S to longitude 121°E.

North along longitude 121°E until latitude 24°S.

West along latitude 24°S until the point where latitude 24°S crosses the western coast.

### **East inspectorate**

Follow the southern coast of WA from the point where the WA-SA border crosses the southern coast to the point where longitude 121°E crosses the southern coast.

North along longitude 121°E until latitude 31°21'S.

West along latitude 31°21'S until longitude 119°40'E.

North along longitude 119°40'E until latitude 26°S.

East along latitude 26°S until the WA-NT-SA border.

South along the WA-SA border until the point where the WA-SA border crosses the southern coast.
