

# What does a safety and health representative do?

## REPRESENTS

fellow workers in matters relating to safety and health in the workplace

## IS CONSULTED

by the mine manager about intended changes to the mine, plant or substances where changes may reasonably be expected to affect employees' safety or health

## CAN BE PRESENT

at an employer's or manager's interview with an employee concerning the occupational safety and health of mineworkers

## REPORTS

immediately to the mine manager and employer any hazard or potential hazard

## CAN CARRY OUT APPROPRIATE INVESTIGATION

in the event of accident, dangerous occurrence or where there is risk of imminent and serious injury

## CAN INSPECT

any part of a mine as agreed with mine manager or as otherwise provided for in the Act

## CONSULTS

and cooperates with the mine manager and employers about all safety and health matters at the mine

## REFERS

appropriate matters to the safety and health committee

## CAN ISSUE

Provisional Improvement Notices (PINs) after completion of the relevant training

## LIAISES WITH

employees, employers and inspectors about safety and health matters
