



Department of Mines and Petroleum trial of four day breach claim period for Recruitment, Selection and Appointment.

Following approval from the Public Sector Standards Commissioner (OPSSC), the Department of Mines and Petroleum is trialling a four day breach claim period for all positions. This process reduces the lodgement period for a complaint of breach from 10 days to 4 days resulting in a faster recruitment time and a reduced likelihood of losing quality applicants.

You will be notified of the outcome of a vacancy and the lodgement process by email (or facsimile if you do not have an email account).

The process for the lodgement of claims has also been reduced to a single page checklist instead of the original lengthy claim. To access the claim form, go to <http://www.opssc.wa.gov.au> and search for “claimant’s checklist”

Managers/Chairpersons will be available to provide feedback to applicants within the four day period, if requested.
