



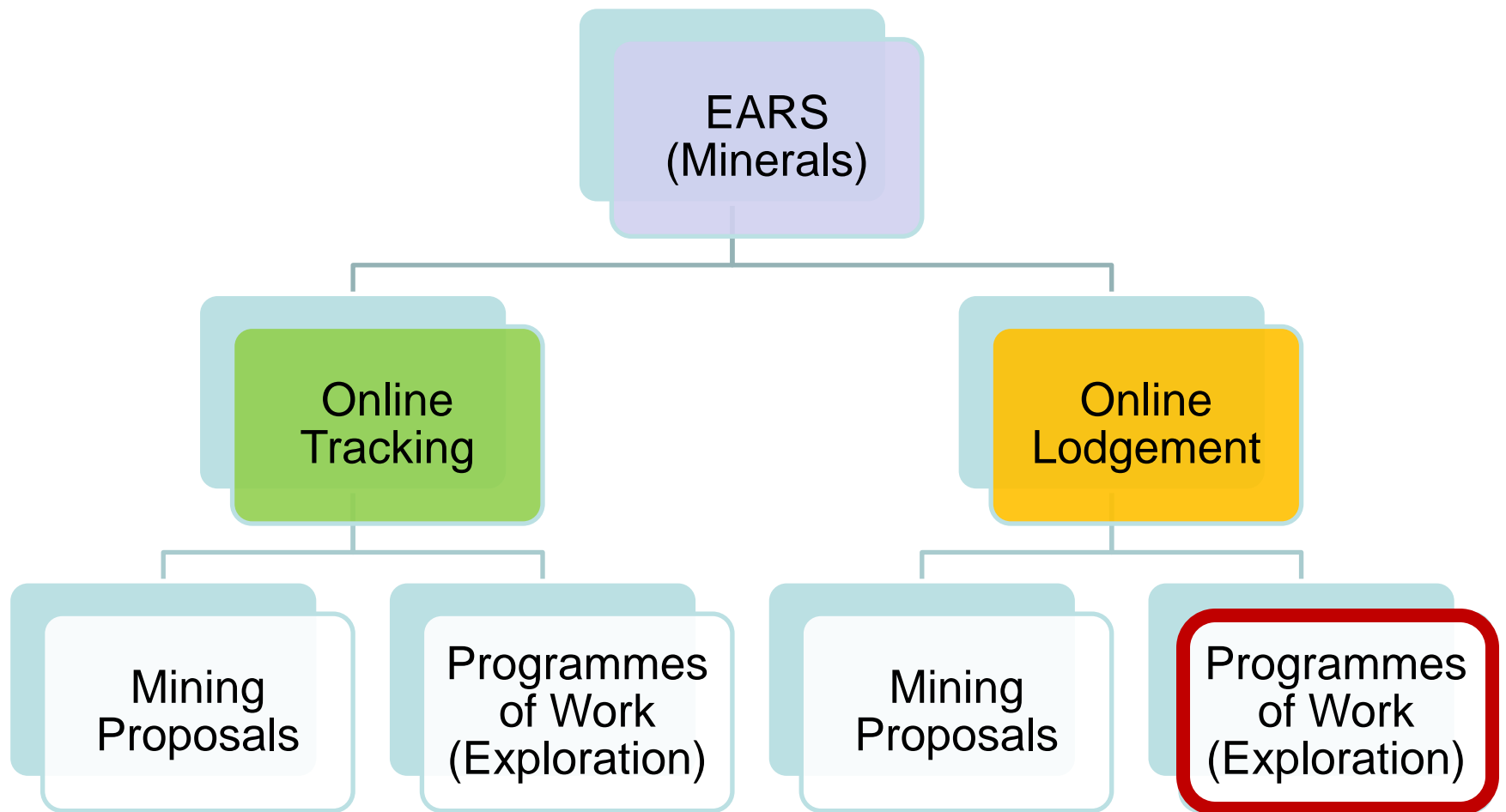

Environmental Assessment and Regulatory System (EARS)



History

- Online lodgement of PoWs originally began on 14 December 2009
- In the last quarter 83% of lodgements were received on-line.
- 98% of these were processed within the agreed timelines.

If approved, the programme will be granted for 12 months from the date shown on the approval letter.

Application for an extension to timeframe can be made to an Environmental Officer prior to the expiry of the approval. A PoW is only valid on live tenure.

These commencement and completion dates are **binding** and rehabilitation **MUST** take place within 6 months of the date of completion of the ground disturbance, (not 6 months from the end date of the programme). Justified extensions require DMP written approval.



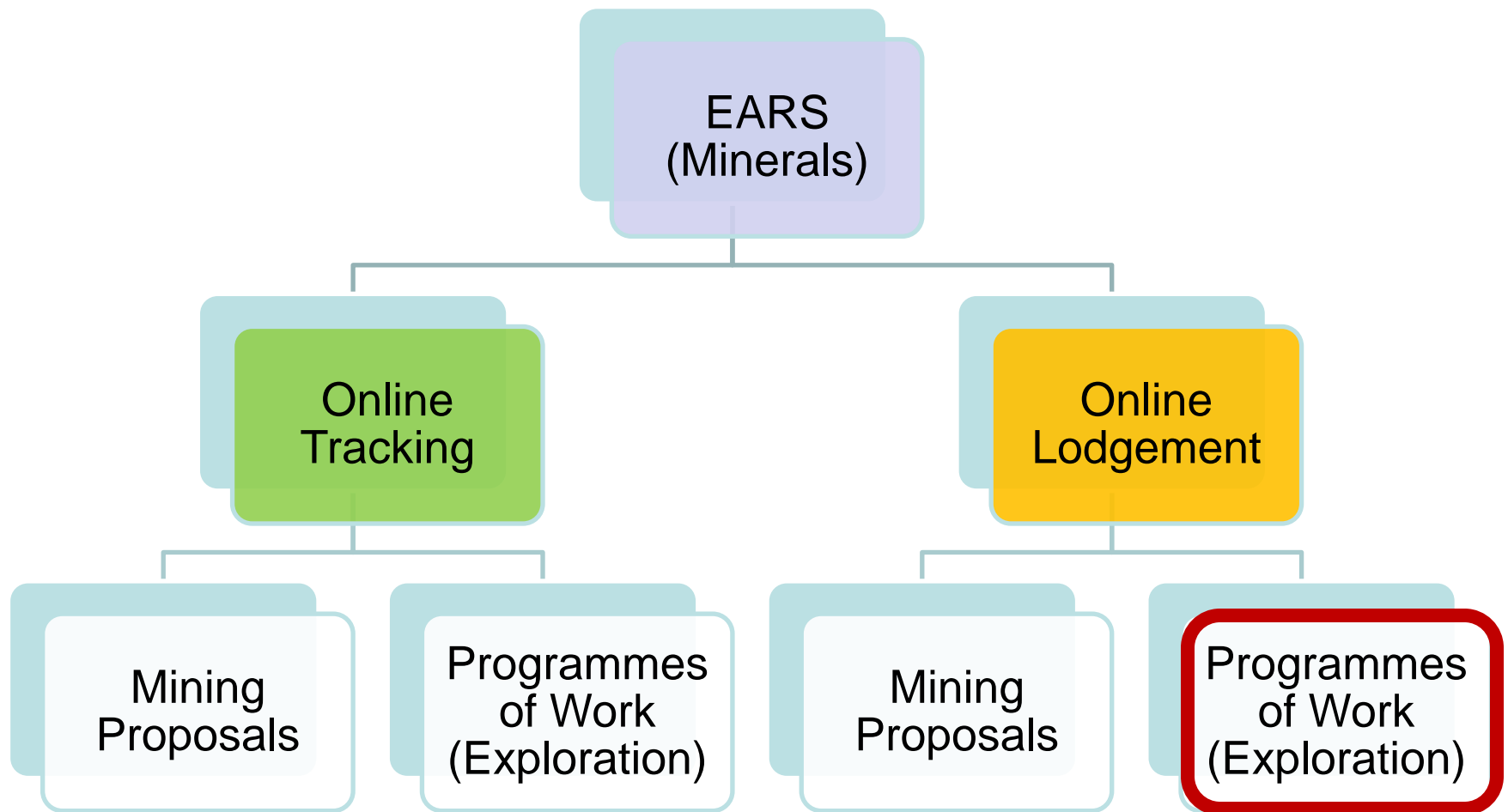
