Petroleum Geothermal Register (PRG)

PGR is a new, easy to use system, which provides information relating to Petroleum and Geothermal titles:

- Simply use a keyword search, available on the PGR Homepage or choose Advanced Search to enable titles searching on a combination of data types.
- The search results are displayed as a list of titles,
- select a title of interest for more information (eg holders and work commitments) about that title.
- The current title version is always displayed, previous versions can be viewed using the renewal history facility.

- Dealings documents (transactions after 1996) can also be viewed.
