The Geological Survey of Western Australia became a key participant in a MERIWA research program to test the HyLogger and promote its use in WA's mining and exploration industry. In 2004 and 2005, at the Joe Lord Core Library in KalgoorlieBoulder, GSWA used the HyLogger for nine weeks and scanned more than 33,000 metres of core.
