To report significant matters related to safety, well or facility integrity incidents in onshore areas which specifically apply to upstream petroleum operations reporting required under the:-

- *Petroleum Pipelines Act 1969* and related regulations;
- *Petroleum and Geothermal Energy Act 1967*; and
- “Schedule Of Onshore Petroleum Exploration And Production Requirements – 1991”.

- interruptions to petroleum production and/or
- medivac evacuation / fatality
