This video provides a general overview of TENGRAPH Web.

TENGRAPH Web opens a map of WA.

The “I want to...” menu contains the most commonly used TENGRAPH tools. More information can be found in the “I want to...” video on the DMIRS website.

The “Layers” panel contains all of the layers of information shown in TENGRAPH.

The scale bar and current scale of view of the TENGRAPH map are down the bottom of the TENGRAPH window.

TENGRAPH Web loads with the Getting Around toolbar active.

Click the “Bookmarked Locations” button and select the “Murchison” from the drop down menu. The green pattern represents granted tenements while the blue pattern represents pending mining tenement applications.

Use tools in the Getting Around toolbar to navigate around the map

Use the Identify Tools tab to query active map layers.

Use the Drawing & Measurement toolbar to create, edit and analyse constructed polygons. For more information see the “Create Polygon” tutorial on the DMIRS website

The Maps & Data Sources tab has a link to the DMIRS Data Centre or can be used add your own data to the map display.

Use the Search Tools tab to access a comprehensive list of search tools. The Advanced Tenement and Advanced Land drop down menus contain more search options.

Use the Printing and Reports tab to run quick appraisals or print maps.

Use the Help & Feedback tab for useful help tools including the Quick Reference Guide and FAQ documents.
