

# New Results Menu

## Transcript

This video shows the new way in which users can view and interact with search results in the TENGRAPH Web system.

TENGRAPH web opens a map of WA.

Click on the “Bookmarked Locations” button to view a list of the default bookmarked locations within TENGRAPH Web. Each location has a set scale and view. Left click on the “Murchison” bookmark. TENGRAPH Web will zoom to a defined scale and view over the Murchison region.

At this scale, live and pending mining tenements are visible but are hard to distinguish. You can use the “Identify Tools” toolbar to identify and query active layers on the TENGRAPH Web map.

Left click on the black triangle next to the “Find Data” tool and select “Rectangle”. To create the rectangle within which you wish to identify data, firstly click and hold down the left mouse button on the map at the position you wish to be the top left corner of the rectangle. Drag your mouse down and right in order to increase the search area. Let go of your left mouse button when you have covered the area that you wish to identify.

TENGRAPH Web lists and summarises the results identified within your defined search area. These results are categorised and the number of results in each category is listed in brackets at the front of each new item. Left click on the Panel Action menu at the top of the Results pane to view a set of actions that can be run on the results list.

In order to open up the “Results Action Menu” in TENGRAPH Web, left click on the three dots at the right hand side of each result category. Left click on the “Zoom to All” option to zoom in on any features within each result category.

To view the entire result list for each summarised category, click on the heading for that particular result. For example, left click on the “Applied for Pending – Public” category to view the results list for the Applied for Pending – Public tenements within the search area. Hover your mouse over each tenement in the results list to see their boundary highlighted on the map.

To view the feature details for a tenement in the results list, left click on the top portion of the result in the list. This shows Attribute, Tenement Data and Current Holder information for the selected tenement. You can also select an action from the options listed above. Left click the cross at the top right of the Feature Details pop up window to close.

To view the “Feature Action Menu” for a tenement in the results list, left click on the three dots to the right of that tenement in the results list. This opens the “Feature Action Menu” which lists a choice of actions that can be run for the desired tenement.

To go back to the “Identify Results” list, left click the back arrow to the left of the “Applied for Pending – Public” menu title. You can switch between the “Layers” pane and the “Identify Results” pane by left clicking the heading at the bottom of the open menu.

To close the “Identify Results” pane, left click the cross to the right of the “Identify Results” title.
