- building an enduring reporting culture where risks, hazards, near misses and incidents are consistently reported, investigated and actioned for monitoring or elimination
- providing high level support and continuing to foster the development of effective health and safety committees, and encouraging employees to nominate as health and safety representatives
- training supervisors and managers in their workplace safety and health responsibilities
- promoting research, innovation and learning in developing the most effective and efficient ways to meet our health, safety and wellness responsibilities.
