- Operating in accordance with occupational safety and health legislation and guidance material such as codes of practice and standards.
- Championing safe and healthy workplaces at the senior leadership level.
- Providing and promoting resources, support and manager training so we can carry out our functions safely and achieve our safety and health outcomes.
- Communicating with the workforce about the benefits of mentally healthy and safe workplaces.
- Encouraging open, honest and effective consultation and communication between managers, staff and OSH representatives to achieve a common understanding of and resolution for all OSH matters.
- Building a culture where risks, hazards and incidents are consistently reported so that:
 - o risks to health, safety and wellness are identified and assessed;
 - o hazards are eliminated or risk to safety is reduced to as low as reasonably practicable;
 - investigations identify root causes and appropriate action is taken to prevent recurrences; and
 - o those who provide services to our organisation adhere to our safety procedures.
