Progress update: 28 January 2015

Work Health and Safety (Mines) Bill and regulations

Drafting of the Work Health and Safety (Mines) Bill has commenced.

On 23 October 2014, WorkSafe tabled its *Work Health and Safety Bill 2014* ('the Green Bill') in Parliament for public comment. Submissions must be sent to the Department of Commerce by 30 January 2015. In 2015, a DMP officer will be working part-time with WorkSafe, to ensure consistency in the development of WHS regulations for mines and for general industry. A WorkSafe officer will also be invited to attend future MAP meetings during development of the regulations.

Regulatory Impact Statement – consolidation of safety legislation

The consultation period for the Regulatory Impact Statement (RIS) for the preferred option for consolidating the safety legislation for mines, petroleum and major hazard facilities closed on 19 December 2014.
