

## Application for Trans-Tasman mutual recognition in Western Australia (excluding dangerous goods and explosives driver, and shotfiring licences)

#### Online dangerous goods licences

Applications for dangerous goods and explosives driver, and shotfiring licences must be made online.

#### Introduction

The Trans-Tasman Mutual Recognition (Western Australia) Act 2007 adopts the Trans-Tasman Mutual Recognition Act 1997 (Cth) ("the TTMR") and was proclaimed on 25 October 2007.

### Principal purpose

One of the principal purposes of the TTMR is to provide the means for promoting the freedom of movement of persons in registered occupations between New Zealand and Australia.

Note: In this information sheet, "States" includes the Australian Capital Territory and the Northern Territory.

#### **Equivalent occupations**

The TTMR enables a person who is registered in connection with an occupation in New Zealand to carry on an occupation determined to be equivalent in Western Australia, subject to any specified requirements.

The TTMR covers occupations for which some form of legislation-based registration, certification, licensing, approval, admission or other form of authorisation is required by individuals in order to legally practice the occupation.

## **General information**

A written notice is required for mutual recognition of a registration from New Zealand.

The notice must:

- state that the person is registered for the occupation in New Zealand; and
- state the occupation for which registration is sought and that is being sought in accordance with the Trans-Tasman mutual recognition principal; and
- specify all the participating jurisdictions in which the person is already registered for equivalent occupations; and
- state that the person is not the subject of disciplinary proceedings in any participating jurisdiction (including any preliminary investigations or action that might lead to disciplinary proceedings) in relation to those occupations; and
- state that the person's registration in any participating jurisdiction is not cancelled or currently suspended as a result of disciplinary action; and
- state that the person is not otherwise personally prohibited from carrying on any such occupation in any participating jurisdiction, and is not subject to any special conditions in carrying on that occupation, as a result of criminal, civil or disciplinary proceedings in any participating jurisdiction; and
- specify any special conditions to which the person is subject in carrying on any such occupation in any participating jurisdiction; and
- give consent to the making of inquiries of and exchange of information with, the authorities of any participating jurisdiction regarding the person's activities in the relevant occupation or occupations or otherwise regarding matters relevant to the notice.

All of the requirements of the notice are outlined in the application form.

The application must be accompanied by the applicant's registration papers or include a copy and a statement certifying that the papers are original or a complete and accurate copy of the original.

The statements and other information contained in the application must also be verified by statutory declaration.

#### **Fees**

The costs of issuing certificates and licences under the TTMR are similar to those for issuing a certificate or licence in Western Australia, and hence the fees are the same.
