Quarter 4 2016

Approvals Performance Report Fourth Quarter 2016 (1 October – 31 December 2016)

In the December quarter 2016, 95 per cent of all applications were finalised within target timelines. Highlights include:

- 99 per cent of mineral prospecting licence applications received were finalised within 65 business days;
- 97 per cent of mineral exploration Programme of Work (PoW) applications received were finalised within 30 business days; and
- 97 per cent of petroleum well applications were finalised within 40 business days.

Summary for calendar year 2016

A total of 7474 mining and petroleum applications were received by the department during the 2016 calendar year, 95 per cent of these were finalised within target timelines.




Figure 1: Number of exploration and prospecting licence applications received during 2015 and 2016 calendar years.

The department received 3992 exploration and prospecting licence applications in the 2016 calendar year. This is a significant increase compared to the 2909 received in the 2015 calendar year (illustrated in Figure 1). The increase in the number of licence applications during 2016 can be attributed to a resurgence of interest in gold exploration, especially in the northern goldfields area.
