




Figure 2 provides a breakdown of the total timeline for the finalisation of exploration licence applications during the quarter and DMIRS performance against the 65 business day performance target. Of the 430 exploration licence applications finalised in the June quarter, 98 per cent were within the performance target.

Figure 2: Exploration Licence total timeline and agency performance






The average **total timeline** to finalise an exploration licence in the June quarter was 294 business days. This includes the time taken for the *Commonwealth Native Title Act 1993* future act process, and times taken for the DMIRS assessment, other government agencies and with the proponent. If exploration licence applications are subject to the Native Title expedited process, this includes a four-month notification period (around 80 business days) prescribed under S29 of the *Native Title Act 1993*.








Environmental Protection Act 1986 - Native vegetation clearing permits
