(3Q 2020)






Figure 2 provides a breakdown of the total timeline for the finalisation of exploration licence applications during the quarter and DMIRS' performance against the 65 business day performance target. Of the 420 exploration licence applications finalised in the September quarter, 99 per cent were within the performance target.

and agency performance







The average **total timeline** to finalise an exploration licence in the September quarter was 233 business days. This includes the time taken for the Commonwealth *Native Title Act 1993* future act process, and the time taken for DMIRS' assessment, other government agencies and the proponent. If exploration licence applications are subject to the Native Title expedited process, they will include a four-month notification period (around 80 business days) prescribed under S29 of the *Native Title Act 1993*.
