DMIRS Occupational Licensing Performance Report September Quarter 2023

The Department of Mines, Industry Regulation and Safety (DMIRS) administers more than 100 diverse and complex licence types. These cover the majority of Western Australia's occupational licensing and include building, painting, plumbing, electrical, gas, WorkSafe, motor vehicle, property industry and other Consumer Protection licensing. These licences all involve a large number of differing legislative, assessment and administrative requirements.

The DMIRS licensing performance target is to finalise at least 80 per cent of applications within the target timeline. For example, DMIRS aims to finalise 80 per cent of Electrician Licence applications within 10 business days. Target timelines are shown in the centre of each 'speedo' figure.

For the September 2023 quarter the department finalised 38,307 applications, an increase of 6.6 per cent over the previous quarter and 18.6 per cent higher than the 2022/23 completion rate.

The increase in applications finalised, and a continuing focus on timeliness of processing, resulted in improved performance in a number of licence categories. Notably gas licensing performance improved once again this quarter with 94 per cent of applications determined within target timeframes and an average processing time of only four business days. Similarly, plumbing licensing achieved significant improvement for the second quarter in a row with 79 per cent of applications determined within target timeframes, an increase of 26 per cent from the previous quarter. Electrical performance remained high with 87 per cent of applications determined within target timeframes, an average processing time of only six business days.


Registered building surveying and owner/builder application performance remained excellent with 94 per cent determined within target timeframes. Registered building contractor and practitioner performance declined with 23 per cent of applications finalised in the quarter being determined within target timeframes. Similarly, painting applications declined with 29 per cent of applications being finalised within target timeframes. Remediation activities are underway and performance in these categories is expected to improve in the December quarter.

High risk work licence performance fell slightly from 42 to 39 per cent, although the average overall timeframe decreased from 21 to 17 business days. Initiatives to improve high risk work licensing performance are underway, although the growing demand for these licences is making improvements challenging.


Property licensing performance remained strong with property application performance increasing once more this quarter with 82 per cent of applications determined within target timeframes and the ten-day processing target being met. Motor vehicle licensing performance declined slightly, although 73 per cent of applications were determined within target timeframes.


The department is continuing to progress initiatives to improve online application and renewal processes.

Distribution of business days to finalise applications - 2023 Q3


