

Note: You should note that the details of the Native Title party to each Regional Standard Heritage Agreement (RSHA) and the parties executing the RSHA on behalf of the Native Title party will vary depending on the geographical location of the area covered by the Exploration/Prospecting Licence application. Similarly the addresses for service of notice, tenement numbers and execution clauses to each RSHA will vary from case to case.

The South West Aboriginal Land and Sea Council (SWALSC) who is the appointed Representative Body for the various Native Title claim groups in its area advised that it would prepare and bind two (2) original copies of the RSHA that will correctly reflect the appropriate information **at no cost**.

You should forward a copy of the “quick appraisal”, along with relevant Grantee Party details, directly to South West Aboriginal Land and Sea Council by email or post to PO Box 585, Cannington WA 6987.
