ONLINE SUBMISSION

PETROLEUM & GEOTHERMAL REGISTER

DMIRS is continuing to improve its interactions with customers by rolling out online systems to ensure a faster and more seamless customer experience for conducting business with the department. These systems will provide 24/7 access and improved processing timelines, as well as reporting benefits and reduced red tape.

Well Management Plan and Field Management Plan modules are now available in PGR, to support the Resource Management Regulations. The information, once submitted, will link to a related title and previously approved Application to Drill.

These two modules will ensure that users can consistently monitor well and field activities. This is the first time that technical data and activities over the lifetime of a well will be captured and stored in one central location.




Online lodgement of applications through PGR

PGR provides industry with the ability to submit petroleum data required under the petroleum acts and regulations.


Online submission of petroleum compliance data allows online lodgement and tracking of the following:

- Well activity and completion reports and data
- Surveys reports and data
- Titles reports and general study reports

The system also specifies the format and the media required for data submitted, provides templates and allows uploading of files up to 150 Mb.



Users must be registered against a company in order to access the online submission system. The data received are strictly confidential; only data lodged by the company you are registered for will be displayed.



The Petroleum and Geothermal Register (PGR) is the Department of Mines, Industry Regulation and Safety's online system that provides information relating to petroleum and geothermal titles.





Online Systems making it easier and quicker by logging on once. This means that only one username and password is needed to access Online Systems where registration is required.


Customers requiring access to PGR for public information about petroleum and geothermal titles do not need to register.


Customers transitioning from paper to digital transactions can register for a free online account for online lodgement of applications and online payment.

An email notification will be sent once access to online lodgement or online payments has been approved.



On the PGR Homepage choose 'Advanced Search' to enable searches of titles and applications using a combination of data types.





'Select' a title of interest for more information (e.g. holders and work commitments) about that title.

The current term of the title is always displayed. Previous terms can be viewed using the 'renewal history' facility.

Instruments showing dealings and transfers of titles can also be viewed.
