

The Department of Mines, Industry Regulation and Safety is the primary safety regulator for the minerals, petroleum and dangerous goods industries in Western Australia. As part of this, appointed mines inspectors undertake regulatory activities, including various actions during site visits that can be proactive or reactive.

The following regulatory indicators represent significant compliance activities undertaken by Mines Safety Inspectors and highlight the Department's continued focus on transparency.

## **Definitions**

- Site visits as recorded on a site visit record (SVR) made by one or more inspectors. Each SVR represents one site visit. Site visit classifications include:
  - Proactive a scheduled, planned visit
  - Reactive an unplanned visit performed reacting to a notification or event
  - Announced the site were made aware of the visit prior to the inspectors attending site
  - Unannounced the site was not made aware of the visit prior to the inspectors attending site
- Improvement notices the number of improvement notices issued
- Prohibition notices the number of prohibition notices issued
- Complaints the number of complaints received from industry and the public regarding alleged unsatisfactory conditions or practices at a mining operation
